## WHAT IS THE HEALTH LEADERS SUMMER ACADEMY?

The Health Leaders Summer Academy provides hands-on educational summer experiences for high school students who are interested in pursuing professional health related careers.



## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Applicants must be current tenth-grade students (rising juniors) with a strong interest in pursuing a career in the medical field. Students must also have completed one year of Biology prior to the start of the Academy. Students in Orange and Osceola counties will only be considered.

Students from underrepresented groups in healthcare will be given first consideration during the application review process. The University of Central Florida College of Medicine values diversity in its education, research and community. Our commitment to reflecting the diversity of the Central Florida community in our faculty, staff and students will guide the applicant selection.



## WHAT WILL I BE DOING?

Throughout the week, students will be exposed to undergraduate level laboratory courses. Faculty at the University of Central Florida will work with academy attendees, engaging them in hands-on experiments and lab processes.

Various offices will provide students with a variety of information vital to their post-secondary educational paths. Students will have the opportunity to network with and receive guidance from representatives from academic offices and colleges across the university and community.
