The digital system has been initiated at the college level in order to ensure accuracy of documentation and to expedite the committee review process at the college level. **Note:** The digital system is only applicable for nominations at UCF College of Medicine. **Should you be awarded the College of Medicine Award for Excellence in Research, the Faculty Development Team will prepare a hard copy of the application in the way prescribed in the University Program Announcement for submission to the appropriate university contact by the deadline of 5:00 PM, February 1, 2016. You will be given the opportunity to review the hardcopy submission before submittal. Alternatively you may prepare your hardcopy submission and give to the Faculty Development Team for submission. This will ensure that you can also be considered for the award at the University level.**

Research Activities

- **Primary Area**: In 100 words or less, describe your primary area of research.
- **Secondary Area**: In 100 words or less, describe the individual's secondary (if any) areas of interest.

- Give a concise description (not to exceed 300 words) of the research achievements of the candidate, discussing, for example, new discoveries, major contributions, creativeness, originality, significant breakthroughs, etc.



- **Research outlets.** Briefly describe (no more than half a page) how the major research publications or other means of research dissemination exceed the norm in the candidate's field. List these publications or major products for dissemination.
- **Research recognition.** Briefly list (no more than half a page) major awards or other evidence of recognition, including major research funding.

Instructions for attaching documents:

1. Click on the paperclip under the comments tab.
