Kirkpatrick Model



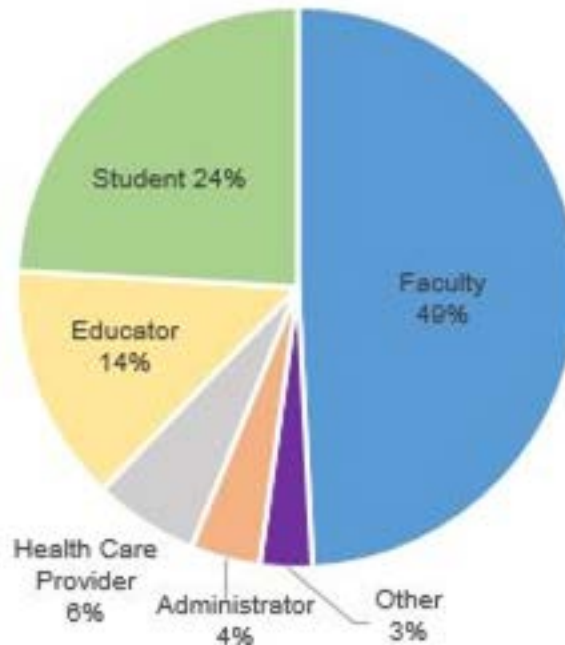


Why submit to Meded Portal?

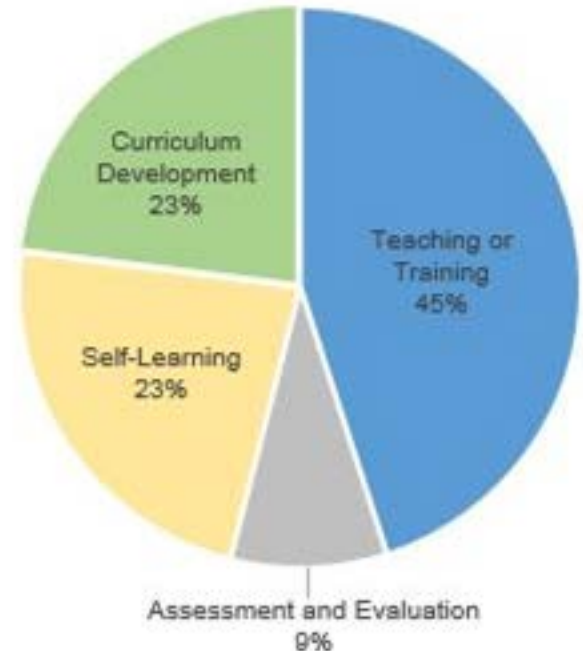

Formatting your materials for MedEdPORTAL

1. Make sure your materials meet the scholarly criteria.

- If not identify what elements you may need to develop or collect for a successful submission

2. Follow the guidelines for the educational summary report (ESR)

Drafting a Plan for Submission

- Identify your project and check MedEdPORTAL to ensure that it is original
 - ◆ If not, see how you could build on similar already published materials to further advance them
- Identify potential collaborators/contributors
- Evaluate whether or not it currently meets scholarly criteria
 - ◆ If not, plan to gather/develop necessary components
- Develop educational summary report
- Submit to MedEdPORTAL
