The Orbis Cyber-Sight retina experience, 2003-2012

Data gathered from this study will assist in the development of a retinal educational curriculum for participating Orbis members in the future.

The effects of phentolamine on cerebral hemodynamics during selective cerebral perfusion at deep hypothermia in the neonatal pig model

- The purpose of this animal study was to determine the effects of a continuous infusion of phentolamine during selective cerebral perfusion on cerebral vascular resistance, oxygen metabolism and neuronal integrity.

Water purification as a preventive public health measure in the Dominican Republic

Co-Investigator (PI: Akash Parekh), May 2008-April 2009

- In this study, water assessment surveys were administered in three isolated mountainous villages that have limited access to potable water in order to determine incidence of diarrheal illness and community perceptions of water contamination. As a result of the study, over 120 families were given access to simple, sustainable water filtration systems.
