Dear GWIMS Community,

The *GWIMSWatch* newsletter is changing based on your feedback. Each issue will now include three articles. One will be an invited contribution, one will be a submission from the community, and the third will be variable, based on the topic and our needs.

We will send out via email a request for pitches (RFP) for articles on a given theme each quarter. A pitch needs to give us enough information to pick an article that will be of interest, but it is not a full manuscript nor outline of an article. How should you construct your pitch?

- The subject line of the email should indicate a response to the RFP
- Include at most three short paragraphs or collections of bullet points
 - What is your topic and/or story line?
 - o Why should readers care?
 - o What makes this aspect of the topic better than any other?
 - o Provide supporting data, web links, etc.
- If you have an image that illustrates the point of your article, include it with your pitch
- Include contact information in case questions arise, especially email and daytime phone number

The theme of the Spring *GWIMSWatch* issue is career advancement. Please send your article pitches to gwims@aamc.org by March 14, 2014. The Communications Subcommittee will review all pitches and select a proposed article for the spring issue by mid-April. The selected author will then have until May 9 to write their full article.
