

LOCKER LOCATIONS

Bay Pines VA:

Student lockers are located in the main hospital, First Floor, Room 1D-164 for women and room 1D-162 for men. This location may change if new lockers cannot fit inside of present locations. Please bring your own lock.

Surgery students may leave their belongings in the secure call room on the 3rd floor near the department offices.

Flagler Hospital:

Students may leave their bags in the book case by the librarian's desk in the medical staff library on 6B. This area is badge-access only and students have access to this area by badge reader. The area is generally manned by either the librarian or the Administrative Resident.

Florida Hospital:

Lockers with combination locks are available in the resident call room area on the ground floor of the hospital.

Heart of Florida:

Currently there is locked space/locked cupboards on the 3rd floor in the Education Department area.

New lockers are scheduled for delivery on October 20th and will be placed on the 3rd floor.

There is a secure area in the call room space on the 3rd floor.

*At the request of the OR Director, students scrubbing in to cases are encouraged to change into their scrubs and leave their possessions in the locked call room due to a shortage of lockers, however they have 1 locker available in the OR changing area that can be shared by all students on surgery rotation – you will need to bring your own lock, and should remove belongings at the end of the day.

Security escort/protective services are available upon request through the hospital operator.

Nemours:

Lockers are available at Nemours – information will be given to you when you go for Orientation on the first day of your rotation.

Security escort/protective services: from a Nemours phone, dial 57-4750.

Orlando Health:

At **ORMC**, Lockers are available for student use outside the 4th floor call rooms on 4C. Students must provide locks for the lockers.

Surgery students may also place their belongings in the locked Surgery Computer Lab on the 4th floor of ORMC's South Tower.

At **Arnold Palmer Hospital**, Pediatric Surgery students may leave backpacks and possessions in the doctor's lounge, which is a badge-access area only.

At **Winnie Palmer Hospital**, **OB M3 students** have access to a locker in the 4th Floor Male and Female locker rooms located outside the 4th Floor Physician Lounge. Each locker room can be accessed with a key code given to the students as they begin their rotation. The lockers are shown to each student during every Orientation tour for the OB Clerkship – the caveat is that there is only one locker available for the students

OB students do leave belongings in the specific service room, as well – each room is locked and can be accessed with a key code:

- Obstetrics (Labor & Delivery – Day & Night Float): 5th Floor Resident Conference Room
- Gynecology Rotation: 1st Floor Physician's Lounge
- Oncology Rotation: 4th Floor Physician's Lounge.

There is an emergency call phone on each floor of the parking deck.

Osceola Regional:

Surgery and IM Students: Lockers are available in the IM/GME area – students must bring their own locks to secure personal belongings.

OB Students: have access to cubbyholes in a secure area in the OB Resident Workroom, which is accessible only by OB residents and faculty and housekeeping staff. Students may also leave belongings in the GME area, which is locked.

Orlando VA

Lockers are available in the Medical Resident trainee lounge (4th floor) – students will need to bring their own locks to secure personal belongings.

Central Florida Regional Hospital

Central Florida Regional Hospital will provide coded lockers for students to leave belongings. However, it is highly suggested not to bring personal items to the hospital. To ensure your items are safe, please bring your own lock. You are welcome to use the coded lock that is currently associated with the locker. CFRH is NOT responsible for any belongings that may come up missing. If you need a locker during your rotation, please let Janneice Caldwell or a member of Staff Development know and they will assist you.

Security escort/Protective Services: Security is located in the Emergency Department and will provide an escort after hours if needed.
