UCF STUDENT ACTIVITIES AND ID CARD

During orientation all medical students are issued a UCF Student ID card, which is separate and distinct from the College of Medicine ID badge. Students must have their UCF Student ID card to take advantage of many university services and facilities. There is a \$10 annual fee for the UCF Student ID card.

The College of Medicine ID badge provides access to the Medical Education building and is also the official identification tag. It should be worn at all times when on the Health Sciences Campus at Lake Nona or in clinical settings. There is a replacement fee if the card is lost or damaged.
