

UCF/HCA GME Consortium Vendor Policy



Purpose/intent: Sponsoring institutions must establish and maintain a policy that addresses interactions between vendor representatives/corporations and residents/fellows and each of its ACGME-accredited programs (Institutional requirement IV.K)

Policy Summary: The UCF COM/HCA GME consortium has adopted the UCF College of Medicine Industry Relations Policy and Guidelines.

- Industry vendors (IV.K.): Residents and faculty will comply with the UCF College of Medicine
 Industry Relations Policy and Guidelines which is reviewed and updated regularly. This policy is
 posted on the electronic resident management system and the UCF website

- 2. All residents and the residency leadership are required to complete and document mandatory training on industry relations. Topics discussed in the policy include: provisions related to not accepting gifts or meals from industry sources, travel funds, prohibitions related to use of pharmaceutical samples, financial and consulting relationships and disclosures, educational and research support, and site access to industry representatives.
- 3. If any participating hospital has a more stringent policy regarding vendors, this will also apply when residents are assigned to that location.
