### Job Description

The University of Central Florida/HCA Graduate Medical Education Consortium of Greater Orlando is seeking a Board Certified Neurologist, who is also Board Certified/Board Eligible in Vascular Neurology, to join their Neurology Residency Program in the role of Associate Program Director.

The Associate Program Director of the Neurology Residency Program will dedicate 70% of his/her time to direct patient care and 30% to Graduate Medical Education. Direct patient care includes inpatient care as part of the comprehensive stroke team, along with continuity care in the outpatient clinic. The APD will train residents in both the clinical and non-clinical environment. APD duties include administration, supervision and didactic teaching.

The Neurology Residency Program's primary site is Osceola Regional Medical Center. Osceola Regional is a 404-bed, Level 2 trauma center with a Comprehensive Stroke Center and Neuroscience Center, providing a full range of services for the prevention, detection, treatment, and rehabilitation of stroke and other neurological disorders. We offer 24/7 Neurology, Neurosurgery, and Interventional Neuroradiology coverage for our stroke patients with a complete continuum of stroke care from specialty trained nurses, nurse practitioners, therapists, pharmacists, and case managers.

Preferred candidates will have completed an ACGME-approved Neurology Residency, and a Fellowship in Vascular Neurology. Supervisory and/or Medical Director experience is a plus. Board Certification by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology in Neurology is required. ABPN Board Certified or Board Eligible in Vascular Neurology required.

The UCF/HCA GME Consortium of Greater Orlando has successfully built residencies and fellowships in Internal Medicine, Endocrinology, Emergency Medicine, OBGYN, Psychiatry, General Surgery and Neurology.

The Neurology Residency Program is centrally located in Kissimmee, Florida only minutes from Orlando, St. Cloud, Celebration and Poinciana.
