### HOW TO ORDER YOUR EQUIPMENT:

1. Go to <http://www.themedicalstore.biz>.
2. Click the 'Schools/Organizations' tab at the top of the page.
3. Enter School Code **ucfcom2019**. This will take you to the UCF COM equipment package that you can customize.
4. After you have made your selections click "Add to Cart" at the bottom of the screen.
5. **To have your order delivered to school for FREE:** Select **"Ship to School"** as your shipping option. Your shipping will be free and your order will be available for pick up at school by August 6th
6. **To have your order shipped directly to you:** select a Shipping option. (Shipping charges will apply.) Orders are processed the same or next business day. Ground shipping is 2-4 days for delivery.
7. **If paying by check:** print an order form and mail it in with your check to: The Medical Store 126 Nantucket Ln. Barrington, IL. 60010

**You must order by July 15<sup>th</sup> 2019 to have your order shipped to school for no charge.**
