- Contact hours, density of modules, quizzes, slide count overwhelmed students
- S2 and S3 adjusted to keep A/B/C/F rubric, but decompressed expectations to focus on core concepts, gave study guidance, and will deliver exams on different days to allow rest and study time between them.
- Apparent double booking of P2 and S module sessions
- Students like Dr. Gros' setup of Panopto videos during the Cardiovascular portion of S-3
- New material vs clinical skills material which served to reinforce knowledge alongside systems modules rather than add new content, which is what happened this year
- Goal to reduce contact hours to 22 or less
- Non-academic pressure on students
- Motion: Separation of S5/S6 exam
- Potential to change schedules so the 2-3 day study period for exams is on a weekend, concerns
- Content in multi-systems module, avoiding over-compression of that module also
- Time/resource constraints for faculty with online format in compressed modules
- Interactive elements to SLMs, downside of slow speed vs loss of interactivity...different function/design of SLMs than lectures
- Step 1 Flexibility:
 - Retention of 6 week study period
 - Potential option to take Step 1 during M3, distraction/forgetting material in the interim
- Moving FIRE conference to after 3rd year? COVID limiting interactions with mentors, student progress.
 - Fire faculty will meet to discuss a potential move/best time
 - Potential for students to present at different times (yearly conference, not all students present in a given year)
