If any of the above sessions are not offered during your six month orientation period, you may complete the corresponding self-learning module to meet the requirement.

Requirement for all Clerkship Educators

If you teach on any of the third year required clerkships (Internal Medicine, Surgery, Psychiatry or Neurology), you must complete the preceptor orientation that corresponds to your specialty annually.
