- The clinic resembles a resident continuity clinic model.
 - You will see patients independently to take the history, physical and work on the assessment
 - You will have the opportunity to do case presentation with the attending, and see the patient together at the examination room

Clinic Hours

- The morning session is from 8:00 am- Noon. **Please arrived at 7:45 AM.**
- The afternoon session is from 1:00 pm-5:00 pm
- Please be on time! You may want to be at least 15 minutes prior to the first patient to touch base with the attending about the case and any specifics to address at the visit.
- Pay attention to your schedule as you will be working with a variety of primary care attendings and specialists.
