

HCA Healthcare Library Update

The Library site has a new look and feel! The [HCA Healthcare library](#) contains over 7400 full-text e-journals and 2200 e-books, as well as a customized HCA PubMed portal, quick links to popular clinical resources like UpToDate, and advanced search and save features. A new partnership with the National Library of Medicine provides [interlibrary loan](#) for articles not available in the HCA Library.

This interactive site is browser-based, mobile compliant, and open to anyone with a 3-4 ID. The library site operates via single sign-on (SSO), so it's extremely simple to access. While on the HCA network, simply navigate to the link below. For off-network access, simply use the same link below and enter your 3-4 ID and network password.

- Browse library holdings via the Library Catalog and set journal alerts (formerly Library eResources Search).
- View the Knowledge Center's evidence summaries and content by clicking the Evidence Services button.
