We are seeking breast cancer and colorectal cancer patients to participate in a research study.

You are invited to participate in our research study!

This research study tests thresholds of FGF19, typically seen in parts of the intestine and gall bladder, especially following a meal. We will test whether FGF19 (along with other markers) are higher in the blood of cancer patients compared to non-cancer participants. If you enroll in this study, you will have to come to the UCF Health Clinic for a fasting blood draw. Breast cancer, colorectal cancer, and non-cancer participants are welcome to volunteer.
