# 1. Review of meeting minutes from the previous meeting - Approved

#### 2. Action Needed

- Findings from educational grants: Dr Bhatti and Celia
- IMFM Clerkship Grading Rubric changes for AY 23-24 an OSCE component is added (to replace professionalism 5% which was redundant). Total points requirement for honors decreased from 93 to 92. All evals have same weight for the total grade. Approved
- IM/FM clerkship objectives were edited Approved
- Surgery clerkship grading rubric changes for AY 23-24: A graded H&P was added for 5% to replace the case report,.
  All evals have same weight for the total grade. These changes are in line with assessment guidelines for clerkships Approved
- Neurology clerkship grading rubric changes for AY 23-24: The case report weight was increased to 5% to replace the peer assessment (which was not considered an optimal assessment) These changes are in line with assessment guidelines for clerkships Approved
- Psychiatry clerkship grading rubric changes for AY 23-24: The direct observations were added to replace the clinical skills evaluations (due to redundancy). H&P weight was increased to 25%. Total points required for H is decreased to 94%. These changes are in line with assessment guidelines for clerkships Approved
- OBGYN clerkship grading rubric changes for AY 23-24:One H&P was added to replace one case presentation for 10%. These changes are in line with assessment guidelines for clerkships Approved
