- d. CREATe taskforce A new assessment system will be developed using multiple assessments methods over time beginning in the pre-clerkship period and continuing across the whole program. A mix of assessments will be implemented in a longitudinal manner throughout the program and feedback will be provided with each assessment. No single assessment will be used to make high stakes decisions(i.e. passing a clerkship). Assessments will be aligned with UCF competencies. Final evaluation and then grades will be the results of a triangulation of different assessment and multiple assessment data points. A competency committee will review all assessment data across the program, identify students with marginal performance, monitor student progression , providing feedback and assessing improvement. Implementation and feasibility will be constantly monitored and evaluated.
