PES Recommendations - Dr. Plochocki

• The following PES recommendations were approved.

S-5 Module:

 The module had 70% A grades. *Review summative assessment rubrics and grading standards to evaluate if changes need to be made. (*Will this be addressed in move to P/F system?)

S-6 Module:

- o Proceed with planned changes:
 - Improve organization by introducing weekly focus.
 - Modify neurology cases to the M2 learner level.
 - Refine rubrics and methods for non-MCQ assessment to minimize participation points.
 - Revisit formative assessments to improve on their quality and value.
 - Revisit clinical content to align it with Step 1 goals and work with clinical faculty to make it more relevant to students.

Clerkship Criteria for Special Review revisions:

- PES would like to provide a more meaningful evaluation of the clerkships. The following revisions to special criteria were proposed:
 - Change "Student evaluation score < 3.5 in any category" to "< 80% Strongly Agree/Agree AND > 15% Disagree/Strongly Disagree student evaluation score in any category".
 - Add new criteria "> 5% of a class fails the subject exam.
