Participant Requirements:

To earn the Clinical Teaching certificate, participants must engage in the complete series of six sessions and demonstrate competence related to course objectives within one year of starting the program. The Faculty Life Team will work with each participant to identify a feasible approach to meeting the certification requirement.

Potential pathways for demonstrating competence include:

- Leading a workshop/session in future iterations of this program
- Leading a workshop/session at your local site based on the program objectives
- Teaching Observation - the participant will be observed modeling/applying the principles taught in the program
- Personal Reflection on how the participant intends to integrate principles to practice
- Additional opportunities available – the program is flexible and willing to consider other ideas based on the participants needs and suggestions
