The UCF College of Medicine is pleased to offer the Master Resident Teaching Certificate Program! This program is aimed at giving Resident educators the essential tools, strategies, and dispositions to deliver high quality clinical education beyond the Resident as Teacher Program.

Delivered as a four-session online series, participants in the program will engage in didactic presentations, group discussions, and case-based exercises focused on the following topics:

- Communication of Goals and Setting Expectations
- Assessment and Evaluation
- Learning Climate and Control of Session
- Providing Effective Feedback

Session dates:

All sessions are held from 12pm - 1pm

Participant Requirements:

To earn the Master Resident Teaching Certification, participants must engage in the complete series of four sessions and demonstrate competence related to course objectives within one year of starting the program. The Continuous Professional Learning Team will work with each participant to identify a feasible approach to meeting the certification requirement.

Potential pathways for demonstrating competence include:

- Leading a workshop/session in future iterations of this program
- Leading a workshop/session at your local site based on the program objectives
- Teaching Observation the participant will be observed modeling/applying the principles taught in the program
- Personal Reflection on how the participant intends to integrate principles to practice
- Additional opportunities available the program is flexible and willing to consider other ideas based on the participants needs and suggestions
