Faculty Answers Policy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All materials for non-mandatory synchronous sessions will be made available. Depending on session type, it may be before, during, or after it. ○ All synchronous session will include a debrief. ○ There be no pre-written faculty answers or guides distributed to students. ○ Clarification to be added for CDL debriefs <p>B. Operationalizing Exam Scheduling Policy – as written</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All materials that has been covered during the course is eligible for both exams ○ IRAT/GRAT may include any basic sciences material since the last TBL. If the scope is narrower than that, it must be communicated to students. AFEs can integrate concepts from BS, CS, and HSS where relevant. If there was a recent CDL, the AFE should reflect it. ○ How exams can proportionately represent long courses, alignment of question count to time spent on material ○ Exam blueprinting – reaching required % for disciplines. Exams need at least 10 items to pull separate reports. Items may cover multiple disciplines. <p>C. IS1 Grading Schema – Tabled until the August 9th meeting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Question and exam weighting, allocation of questions to differently weighted exams ○ Discussion on flexibility with item count, compensating for minimum questions <p>D. Time for MCQ based assessments – as written</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ NBME MCQ gives 90 seconds per question. Since this will be the case for M1 exams, COM will standardize MCQ to 90 seconds generally. <p>E. Clarification of Weekly Formative Quiz Content – as written</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Weekly quizzes are based on content covered that week. ○ They will be released Monday of the week in question. ○ Formative quizzes should reflect what is assessed on MCQ on summative exams <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ BS and HSS only 	<p>A.
